AN ORDINANCE granting an extension of preliminary approval for the Plat of Ivy Ridge (BALD File No. 289-2).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Findings. The King County Council finds that:

A. The applicant has filed a written request for an extension of twelve months for preliminary plat approval.

B. The applicant has complied with and met the provisions of the King County code and state law.

C. The applicant has made substantial progress in complying with the conditions of preliminary approval.

D. It would be inequitable to require the applicant to reapply.

SECTION 2. Preliminary approval for the plat of Ivy Ridge (BALD File No. 289-2) is granted an extension to expire on December 11, 1993.
