AN ORDINANCE making an additional appropriation of \$5,951 to the Public Works ER&R Fund from unencumbered fund balance for removal of an underground waste oil storage tank at the Renton Consolidated Facility, and amending Ordinance No. 10182, Section 90, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$5,951 to the Public Works ER&R Fund from the unencumbered fund balance of the underground storage tank reserve account for the removal of a 2,000 gallon underground waste oil storage tank located on the south side of Building "G" in the Renton Consolidated Office and Repair Facility.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 10182, Section 90, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:
