
STATEMENT OF FACTS

- A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of 26th Avenue South in Council District No. 7, hereinafter described (V-2087).
- The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements are not required.
- The building and land development division has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- The conditions established by the department of public works as part of the recommendation for vacation have been met. The removal of the cul-de-sac and the reconstruction of 26th Avenue South are now included in the development plans for the proposed plat of Alder Glen.
- The right-of-way is classified "D Class" and, in accordance with King County Code 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is \$200.00 to cover administrative costs. King County is in receipt of \$200.00 from the petitioner.
- 6. The department of public works considers the subject right-of-way useless as part of the county road system, and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County council on the 3000 day of Ylovember, 1992

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
