ORDINANCE NO.

10661

AN ORDINANCE relating to park and recreation facilities fees, and amending Ordinance No. 5225, Section 2(A), (B), (C), as amended, Ordinance 9227, Section 1(Part), as amended and K.C.C. 7.08.020, .025, .030 and 040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5225, Section 2(A), as amended, and K.C.C. 7.08.020 are amended to read as follows:

Swimming pool facilities (except Weyerhaeuser King County Aquatics Center). Swimming pool facilities ((feels)) fees shall be:

Public Swims: \$1.25 per person per session

~~((Provide, however, that for Evergreen Pool only public swims shall be FREE in the period beginning on Monday, June 29, 1992 through Saturday, August 29, 1992 only; Mondays through Fridays from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Saturdays from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.))~~

Seventy-five Cent Swims: . . .75 per person per session

Adult Only Swims: 2.00 per person per session

Senior citizens-60 years plus \$1.25 per person for any program session.


