## ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying, in part, and denying, in part, a portion of certain property upon the application of THOMAS L. THORNTON, designated Building and Land Development File No. L91RZ003.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the November 18, 1992, report of the zoning and subdivision examiner filed with the clerk of the council on December 3, 1992, on the application of Thomas L. Thornton to reclassify certain property described in building and land development file no. L91RZ003.

SECTION 2. The recommendation of the zoning and subdivision examiner to reclassify a portion of the subject property from AR-5 Rural Area (Potential ML-P Light Manufacturing, site plan approval required) to ML-P (Light Manufacturing, site plan approval required), subject to conditions, and, to deny reclassification of that portion of the subject property which is located within the shoreline management Conservancy Environment, is hereby adopted by the Council of King County.
