ORDINANCE NO. 10672

AN ORDINANCE changing the name of
Southwest 242nd Street to Southwest
Governors Lane petitioned pursuant to
Attachment A.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 10637, Sections 1-3 is repealed.

SECTION 2. Southwest 242nd Street, in its entirety,
described as an east and west road running northwesterly along
the south portion of the east half of government lot 1 in
section 19, T. 22 N., R. 3 E.W.M. and along the shoreline in
the southeast quarter of government lot 3 in section 20, T.22
N., R. 3 E.W.M., is renamed as Southwest Governors Lane.

SECTION 3. The public notice requirements contained in
Ordinance 8766, Section 10 shall be met. The required number
of petition signatures has been satisfied pursuant to
Attachment A. Technical advice was received from the division
of building and land development and Fire District No. 13.

SECTION 4. The director of public works shall accomplish
the necessary sign changes within sixty days of the passage of
this ordinance.
