

ORDINANCE NO. **10724**

AN ORDINANCE relating to drug-free zones; approving a map of the location and boundaries of areas in the Snoqualmie Valley School District No. 410 within which unlawful transactions in controlled substances are subject to enhanced penalties pursuant to RCW 69.50.435, and adding a new section to K.C.C. 12.82.

PREAMBLE:

K.C.C. 12.82 establishes a procedure for the production or reproduction of maps depicting the location and boundaries of parks, schools and areas within one thousand feet of schools, within which unlawful transactions in controlled substances are subject to enhanced penalties as imposed pursuant to RCW 69.50.435. Upon request of the governing body of the Snoqualmie Valley School District No. 410, King County has prepared a map depicting such boundaries. It is in the public interest to provide notice of the location of such areas and to expedite prosecution, conviction, and enhanced penalties for cases of unlawful transactions in controlled substances in such locations.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The boundaries of drug-free zones surrounding the following schools as listed in Exhibits "A" thru "F" located within the Snoqualmie Valley School District No. 410 are hereby adopted:

- A. Fall City Elementary School
- B. North Bend Elementary School
- C. Opstad Elementary School
- D. Chief Kanim Middle School
- E. Snoqualmie Elementary, Snoqualmie Middle School and Mt. Si Athletic Fields
- F. Mt. Si Senior High School


