ORDINANCE NO. **10708**

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AN ORDINANCE establishing the date for an election on the question of annexation of the City of Woodinville to the Woodinville Fire and Life Safety and declaring an emergency.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The interim city council for the City of Woodinville, Washington by Ordinance No. 001, has initiated the proposed annexation and expressed its intent to join the Woodinville Fire and Life Safety District, effective immediately upon the effective date of incorporation of the City, finding that the public interest will be served thereby.

City of Woodinville Ordinance No. 001 does satisfy the provisions of RCW 52.04.061 and 52.04.071 requesting the calling of an election to be held among the qualified voters therein.

The Commissioners of the Woodinville Fire and Life Safety District by Resolution No. 399 has concurred with the proposal of the council of the City of Woodinville and their intent to join the District by annexation as submitted on December 15, 1992, all in accordance with RCW 52.04.061.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A special election shall be held on the 9th day of March, 1993, within the City of Woodinville and in the Woodinville Fire and Life Safety District. The ballot proposition shall be in substantially the following form in accordance with RCW 57.04.071:

"Shall the City of Woodinville, Washington be annexed to and be part of the Woodinville Fire and Life Safety District effective immediately upon the effective date of the incorporation of the City?"

SECTION 2. Notice of election shall be published as required by law.


SECTION 3. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace,

2 its existing public institutions.


