AN ORDINANCE relating to drug-free zones; approving a map of the location and boundaries of areas in the Issaquah School District No. 411 within which unlawful transactions in controlled substances are subject to enhanced penalties pursuant to RCW 69.50.435, and adding a new section to K.C.C. 12.82.

PREAMBLE:

K.C.C. 12.82 establishes a procedure for the production or reproduction of maps depicting the location and boundaries of parks, schools and areas within one thousand feet of schools, within which unlawful transactions in controlled substances are subject to enhanced penalties as imposed pursuant to RCW 69.50.435. Upon request of the governing body of the Issaquah School District No. 411, King County has prepared a map depicting such boundaries. It is in the public interest to provide notice of the location of such areas and to expedite prosecution, conviction, and enhanced penalties for cases of unlawful transactions in controlled substances in such locations.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The boundaries of drug-free zones surrounding the following schools as listed in Exhibits "A" thru "K" located within the Issaquah School District No. 411 are hereby adopted:

- D. Challenger Elementary School
- Ε. Discovery Elementary School
- Maple Hills Elementary School
- G. Sunny Hills Elementary School
- Η. Sunset Elementary School

- Liberty Senior High School Κ.
