ORDINANCE NO. 10725

AN ORDINANCE approving the City of Bellevue
Water Comprehensive Plan.

PREAMBLE:

K.C.C. 13.24 requires approval of comprehensive plans for water purveyors as a prerequisite to the granting of right-of-way franchises and approval of right-of-way construction permits.

The City of Bellevue Water Comprehensive Plan was approved by vote of the Bellevue City Council on October 19, 1992.

On August 26, 1992 the King County Utilities Technical Review Committee met to consider the plan and finding it consistent with K.C.C. 13.24 recommended approval.

The City of Bellevue issued a determination of nonsignificance in accordance with the State Environmental Policy Act on June 15, 1992.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The City of Bellevue Water Comprehensive Plan, attached as Exhibit A, is hereby approved with no conditions.
