ORDINANCE NO. 10749

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Brunton No. 37 to Cedar River Water and Sewer District for water service only

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area for water service known as Brunton No. 37 to Cedar River Water and Sewer District was filed with the county council effective February 3, 1993.
- Cedar River Water and Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 3085 concurred with the proposed annexation.
- Cedar River Water and Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated November 17, 1992, on the proposed annexation.
 - The county council held a public hearing on the 8th day of Manh _, 1993 considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation of Cedar River Water and Sewer District of the area known as Brunton No. 37 and described in Section 4 herein is approved.

The Cedar River Water and Sewer District is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed for water service only.

SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, franchises, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area, nor does it authorize sewer service in any area not designated as a "Local Service Area" by the King County Sewerage General Plan.

SECTION 4. The area known as Brunton No. 37 to be annexed is:
