AN ORDINANCE relating to boating regulations; prohibiting the use or operation of internal combustion engines on Lake Holm; and adding a new section to K.C.C. 12.44.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:


NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. There is added to K.C.C. 12.44 a new section to read as follows:

Lake Holm Restrictions. It is unlawful to use or operate any internal combustion engine on Lake Holm, legally defined as all the water of Lake Holm (formerly Neilson Lake) located within the SE 1/4 of Section 14, Township 21 North, Range 5 East, W.M., in King County, Washington; provided that, nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent any public official or construction company from performing authorized duties. The department of public works shall have the responsibility of posting and maintaining appropriate signs.


INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 11<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1993.
