ORDINANCE NO. **10759**

AN ORDINANCE approving the King County Water District No. 19 Water System Comprehensive Plan.

PREAMBLE:

K.C.C. 13.24 requires approval of comprehensive plans for water purveyors as a prerequisite to the granting of right-of-way franchises and approval of right-of-way construction permits.

On December 9, 1992 the King County Utilities Technical Review Committee met to consider the plan and finding it consistent with K.C.C. 13.24 recommended approval.

The King County Water District No. 19 Water System Comprehensive Plan was approved by vote of the general membership of the Water District on May 21, 1992.

The King County Water District No. 19 issued a determination of nonsignificance in accordance with the State Environmental Policy Act in May 1992.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
