AN ORDINANCE establishing the date for an election on the question of annexation of the City of Duvall into the King County Rural Library District, and declaring an emergency.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The City of Duvall, Washington by Ordinance No. 672, has initiated the proposed annexation and expressed its intent to join the King County Rural Library District, finding that the public interest will be served thereby. The City of Duvall Library Board in a letter dated February 22, 1993 recommends presenting the question before the voters.

City of Duvall Ordinance No. 672 does satisfy the provisions of R.C.W. 27.12.010 (5), and 27.12.360 requesting the calling of an election to be held among the qualified voters therein.

The Board of Trustees of the King County Rural Library District by Resolution No. 1993-6 has concurred with the proposal as submitted on March 9, 1993, all in accordance with RCW 27.12.360.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A special election shall be held on the 18th day of May, 1993, within the City of Duvall, Washington. The ballot proposition shall be in substantially the following form in accordance with RCW 27.12.370:

"Shall the City of Duvall, Washington be annexed to and be part of the King County Rural Library District?"

SECTION 2. The Records & Elections Division is directed to conduct the election by mail and notice of election shall be published as required by law.


SECTION 3. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exist and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace,

2 its existing public institutions.


