ORDINANCE NO. **10785**

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$274,332 to the Building Modernization Fund No. 3310, from Interfund Rent for the following Capital Improvement Projects: No. 667005, BALD Lease, and No. 667001, Smith Tower Lease; and amending Ordinance 10182, Section 97, Attachments 1 and 2, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$274,332 to the Building Modernization Fund No. 3310, from Interfund Rent for the following Capital Improvement Projects: No. 667001 - Smith Tower Lease (\$103,539) and No. 667005 - BALD Lease (\$170,792).

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 10182, Section 97 as amended is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

From the several capital improvement project funds, there is hereby appropriated and authorized to be disbursed the following amounts for the specific projects identified in Attachment No. 1 of this ordinance.
