AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of \$167,123 to the Prosecuting Attorney - CJ, from the unencumbered Criminal Justice Fund balance, and amending Ordinance 10641, Section 57, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation of \$167,123 from the unencumbered Criminal Justice Fund balance to the prosecuting attorney - CJ to provide additional temporary resources to the appellate unit.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 10641, Section 57, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

PROSECUTING ATTORNEY - CJ - From the Criminal Justice Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Prosecuting Attorney - CJ \$167,123

The maximum number of additional FTEs for Prosecuting Attorney - CJ shall be: 3.75

PROVIDED THAT:

If the State does not re-authorize the Washington Association of Defense Attorneys (WADA) Backlog Reduction Project beyond July 1, 1993, the office of the Prosecuting Attorney FTE authority will be reduced by 1.5 FTE attorney and .5 FTE legal office technician effective July 1, 1993.


\$38,846 shall be transferred to an OPA contingency account and only made available upon State re-authorization of WADA Backlog Reduction Project beyond July 1, 1993, and approval of the Office of Financial Management.

If the use of private indigent defense agencies, Multiple Agency Pilot Project, is not re-authorized beyond July 1, 1993, the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney FTE authority will be reduced by 2.5 FTE attorneys and .5 FTE paralegal effective October 1, 1993.
