ORDINANCE NO. **10796**

AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of \$177,479 to CIP Project No. 334001, Fuel Tank Removal - Precinct 2, from the unencumbered fund balance of Fund 334, the Capital Acquisitions and County Facilities Fund, and amending Ordinance 10641, Section 109, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation of \$177,479 to the CIP Project No. 334001, Fuel Tank Removal - Precinct 2, from the unencumbered fund balance of Fund 334, the Capital Acquisitions and County Facilities Renovation Fund, to provide for environmental clean-up at Precinct 2.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 10641, Section 109, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

From the several capital improvement project funds there are hereby appropriated and authorized to be disbursed the following amounts for the specific projects identified in Attachment No. 2 of this ordinance.




