AN ORDINANCE relating to the Disincorporation of Lake Hills Sewer District and King County Water District No. 97.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A request to the King County Council for the formal disincorporation of Lake Hills Sewer District and King County Water District No. 97 was filed with the county council on March 4, 1993.
- 2. The City of Bellevue by Resolution No. 5543 calls for the disincorporation of the Lake Hills Sewer District and King County Water District No. 97.
- 3. Neither of the subject districts have actively carried out any functions within the last five years. Those two districts have never been formally dissolved.
- 4. All assets, liabilities and debt were transferred to the City in 1972 and 1973. There is nothing left to liquidate. The agreements provided for the districts to remain as a separate entity on paper until January 1, 1990 to assure that the provisions of the agreement were carried out by the City.

5. The county council held a public hearing on the _____ day of _____, 19____ and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 57.90.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The disincorporation of Lake Hills Sewer District and King County Water District No. 971 is approved.
