ORDINANCE NO. **10957**

AN ORDINANCE approving the Highline Water District Water Conservation Plan as an amendment to the Highline Water District 1989 Comprehensive Water Plan.

PREAMBLE:

K.C.C. 13.24 requires approval of comprehensive plans for water purveyors as a prerequisite to the granting of right-of-way franchises and approval of right-of-way construction permits.

On July 8, 1991 the King County Council conditionally approved the Highline Water District 1989 Comprehensive Water Plan pending the submittal of a conservation plan.

The Highline Water District Water Conservation Plan was approved by vote of the Highline Water District on December 16, 1992.

On January 13, 1993 the King County Utilities Technical Review Committee met to consider the conservation plan and finding it consistent with K.C.C. 13.24 recommended approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Highline Water District Water Conservation Plan, attached as Exhibit A, is hereby approved with no conditions as an amendment to the Highline Water District 1989 Comprehensive Water Plan.
