AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying certain property upon the application of RICHARD LOMAS, designated Land Use Services File No. L92RZ009.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the July 7, 1993, report of the zoning and subdivision examiner filed with the clerk of the council on July 22, 1993, on the application of Richard Lomas to reclassify certain property described in land use services file no. L92RZ009.

SECTION 2. The recommendation of the zoning and subdivision examiner to reclassify the subject property from GR 5-P (RS-5,000-P) to RM-900-P, subject to conditions, modified, is hereby adopted. The conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within one year of council approval, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. (If there are no preeffective conditions, the effective date shall be ten days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the land use services division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
