ordinance no. 10982

AN ORDINANCE relating to school impact fees in the Kent School District; establishing school impact fees to be collected by King County on behalf of the district; adopting the Capital Facilities Plan of the district as an element of the King County Comprehensive Plan for purposes of implementing the impact fee program; adding a new section to K.C.C. 20.12; and amending Ordinance No. 10122, Section 2 and K.C.C. 27.44.010.

FINDINGS:

- 1. In compliance with the Growth Management Act and King County Ordinance No. 10162, the Board of Directors of Kent School District No. 415 adopted a Capital Facility Plan (Plan) on April 28, 1993.
- 2. The Plan has been reviewed by the King County School Technical Review Committee (STRC). On May 20, 1993 the STRC recommended the adoption of the Plan as part of the King County Comprehensive Plan.
- 3. The Plan contains the information required under the Growth Management Act and King County Ordinance No. 10162.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Authority. This ordinance is adopted to implement King County Comprehensive Plan policies, the 1990 Growth Management Act, and Ordinance No. 10162 with respect to Kent School District No. 415. This ordinance is necessary to address identified impacts of development on the District in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare, and to implement King County's authority to impose impact fees pursuant to RCW 82.02.050 through RCW 82.02.080.

<u>NEW SECTION. SECTION 2</u>. A new section is hereby added to K.C.C. Chapter 20.12 to read as follows:

Kent School District No. 415 Capital Facilities Plan, 1993-94 - 1998-99, revised May 1993, which is included in Attachment A and is incorporated herein by reference, is adopted as a subelement of the capital facilities element of the Comprehensive Plan for King County, and augments and amplifies the Plan.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 10122, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 27.44.010 are hereby amended to read as follows:

A. Base Fee Schedule. The following fees shall be assessed for the indicated types of development:

- B. Assessment of Fees. The assessment and collection of Tahoma's impact fees are governed by K.C.C. 21.61A.060.
- C. County's Administrative Costs. The county's costs of administering the impact fee program shall be sixty-five dollars per dwelling unit and shall be paid by the applicant to the county as part of the development application fee.
