AN ORDINANCE adopting the King County Arterial High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) Plan as an element of the King County Transportation Plan.

PREAMBLE:

The adopted King County Comprehensive Plan and the King County Transportation Plan recognize the county-wide need to accommodate HOV modes of travel on the county road system, and directed the development of specific plans and programs to accomplish this goal.

In addition, the passage of the 1991 federal Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) has provided significant financial and legislative policy incentives for the integration of nonmotorized transportation planning projects and programs into the existing transportation systems.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Arterial HOV Transportation
Plan's determination of non-significance is adequate to support
adoption of the plan.

SECTION 2. The King County Arterial HOV Transportation Plan, dated March 1993, is adopted as the arterial HOV transportation functional plan implementing related policies established in the adopted King County Comprehensive Plan and the King County Transportation Plan, and constitutes an amplification and augmentation of official county policy with regard to surface transportation issues.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> The Arterial HOV Transportation Plan shall be implemented through:

- A. Integration of HOV projects into the annual six year capital improvement program and the annual transportation project priority process,
 - B. Updating of the King County Road Standards
- C. County road maintenance and operating revisions and improvements.
- D. Pursuit of additional public and private capital, maintenance and program funds at the local, regional, state and federal level for HOV improvements, and
