AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$3,148,936 to the Open Space Bond Fund from unappropriated fund balance representing 1992 interest earnings on the open space bonds and allocating these amounts to the City of Seattle, and suburban cities open space projects, amending Ordinance 10641, Section 109, and Attachment 2, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$3,148,936 to the Open Space Bond Fund from unappropriated fund balance representing 1992 interest earnings on the open space bonds allocating these amounts to the city of Seattle, and suburban cities open space projects.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 10641, Section 109, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

From the several capital improvement project funds there are hereby appropriated and authorized to be disbursed the following amounts for the specific projects identified in Attachment 2 of this ordinance.

Provided That:

No 1992 interest earnings are transferred to a jurisdiction until a first half 1993 status report for that jurisdiction's projects is approved by the Parks, Open Space and Natural Resources Committee.
