ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to school impact fees; adopting the Capital Facilities Plans of the Tahoma, Federal Way, Riverview, and Issaquah School Districts as elements of the King County Comprehensive Plan for purposes of implementing the impact fee program; establishing impact fees to be collected by King County on behalf of the districts; and amending Ordinance 10122, Section 2 and 3 and K.C.C. 27.44.010 and K.C.C. 20.12.460, Ordinance 10470, Section 2 and K.C.C. 20.12.461, Ordinance 10472, Section 2 and K.C.C. 20.12.462, and Ordinance 10633, Section 2 and K.C.C. 20.12.463.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. Authority. This ordinance is adopted to implement King County Comprehensive Plan policies, the 1990 Growth Management Act, and Ordinance No. 10162 with respect to Tahoma School District, Federal Way School District, Riverview School District, and Issaguah School District. ordinance is necessary to address identified impacts of development on the Districts in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare, and to implement King County's authority to impose impact fees pursuant to RCW 82.02.050 through RCW 82.02.080.
