AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as "Dash Point State Park" to the Federal Way Water and Sewer District for sewer service.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as "Dash Point State Park" for the West end Service Area to the Federal Way Water and Sewer District for sewer service, was filed with the county council effective August 31, 1993.
- 2. Federal Way Water and Sewer District has found the petition for annexation for sewer service to be sufficient and has by Resolution 93-693 concurred with the proposed annexation.
- 3. Federal Way Water and Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated January 11, 1993, on the proposed annexation.
- 4. The county council held a public hearing on the 27th day of September, 1993 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Federal Way Water and Sewer District for sewer service, of the area known as "Dash Point State Park" annexation and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 56.02.060.

SECTION 2. Federal Way Water and Sewer District is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed for sewer service.

Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide sewer service to this annexation area. SECTION 4. The area known as "Dash Point State Park" 5. Annexation for sewer service is described as follows: Government Lots 2 and 3, and the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 10, Government Lot 1 and the northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 15; and

the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 14; EXCEPT County roads; All in Township 21 North, Range 3 East, W.M., in King County, Washington;

EXCEPT THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PARCELS:

a) That portion of said Government Lot 3, Section 10, described as follows:

Beginning on the Easterly line of Puyallup Indian Reservation, being the Southwesterly line of said Lot 3, at a point which is North 45° West 14.14 feet from the intersection of said line with the center line of Birch Street on the plat of Fairview Park Tracts, according to plat recorded in Volume 8 of Plats, Page 120 in Pierce County, Washington; thence North 2°36′ West 218.28 feet; thence North 89°45′ East 93.46 feet; thence North 27°00′00″ West to the Government meander line; thence Southwesterly along said meander line to the Westerly line of said Government Lot; thence South 45° East to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
