## ORDINANCE NO. 11103

AN ORDINANCE relating to taxation and use tax reauthorizing an additional sales and use tax upon and to be collected from those persons from whom the state sales and use tax is collected; fixing the rate of tax; and amending Ordinance No. 8325, Section 1 and K.C.C. 4.28.016.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 8325 Section 1 and K.C.C.
4.28.016 are hereby amended to read as follows:

There is hereby levied an additional sales or use tax, Α. as the case may be, as authorized by laws of (1990, 2d ex. sess., chap. 1, sec. 901 and 82.14 RCW, and by the voters of King County at a special election on September 18, 1990,) 1993, 1st special sess. chap. 21, sec. 6, and RCW 82.14.340, that shall be collected from those persons who are taxable by the state pursuant to chapters 82.08 and 82.12 RCW upon the occurrence of any taxable event within King County. ordinance shall take effect January 1, 1994. The tax shall take effect ((beginning November 1, 1990 and it shall expire January 1, 1994)) upon the effective date of this ordinance. The moneys received from such tax shall be expended exclusively for criminal justice purposes and shall not be used to replace or supplant existing funding pursuant to the restrictions on the use of these funds in RCW 82.14.340.

B. The rate of the additional tax imposed by Subsection
A. shall be one-tenth of one percent of the selling price of
value of the article used, as the case may be.

SECTION 2. For the purpose of this ordinance and any proposed referendum on it, the clerk of the council shall be the filing officer for the purpose of receiving a proposed referendum petition, conferring with the petitioner regarding form and style, and issuing an identification number for the petition. The prosecuting attorney shall prepare the ballot
