

ORDINANCE NO. **11133**

AN ORDINANCE relating to paid parking in County owned parking facilities; and amending Ordinance 8753, Section 5 and 6 as amended, and K.C.C. sections 3.32.045 and 3.32.055.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 8753, Section 5, as amended and K.C.C. Section 3.32.055 are each hereby amended as follows:

Parking rates - parking stalls. Effective ((January 1, 1993))

January 1, 1994 monthly rates for parking stalls in the King County automotive center, adult detention center, courthouse, Yesler Building, open surface parking lots, and bicycle lockers shall be as follows:

Effective January 1, 1994, the facilities management division, department of construction and facilities management, is empowered to identify surface parking lots for which it is reasonable and feasible to charge employees for monthly parking, and to implement such charges. These surface parking lots are located at county facilities outside the downtown Seattle metropolitan core and include, but are not limited to, district courts, health centers, alcohol treatment facilities, police precincts, youth service centers, public works facilities.

1 f. Washington Center

2 Covered Parking \$50.00

3 Uncovered Parking \$40.00

4 For disabled county employees whose disabilities make it difficult or
 5 impossible to use public transit, and who display a disabled parking permit, the
 6 fee for covered parking shall be 50 percent of the normal rate. Employees with
 7 disabilities shall receive first priority in the assignment of available parking
 8 stalls.

9 Authorized second and third shift parking and interim use parking in the
 10 automotive center shall be limited to floors ((five)) four through seven.

11 The executive will notify 2nd and 3rd shift employees of the availability
 12 of escort service.

13 SECTION 2. Ordinance 8753, Section 6, as amended, and K.C.C. 3.32.045
 14 are each hereby amended as follows:

15 Parking rates - ((surface parking lots)) 5th and Jefferson public parking
 16 lot. The parking rates for parking ((in designated open surface parking lots))
 17 shall be as follows:

18 A. Daily parking:

19 1. Effective January 1, ((1992:)) 1994:

20	0 - 2 hours	\$3.00
21	2 - 4 hours	\$5.00
22	4 - 10 hours	\$7.00
23	<u>Early Bird Special</u>	<u>\$6.00</u>
24	<u>(Weekdays prior to 8:30 a.m.)</u>	
25	Special events	((\$7.00)) <u>\$6.00</u>

26 PROVIDED THAT:

27 County employees not permanently assigned to a downtown work station shall
 28 pay no more than \$75.00 in any calendar month for such unassigned parking.

29 2. Evenings after 6 p.m. and all day Saturday, Sunday and legal
 30 holidays except during special events. \$4.00

1 B. Special events rates - conditions. Special events rates shall apply
2 after 6 p.m. weekdays and all day Saturday, Sunday and legal holidays and shall
3 apply during those events designated in accordance with Section 3.32.010.
4 Parking for special events shall be provided in surface lots and in the county
5 automotive center, provided that county employees who pay for parking privileges
6 in the automotive center shall be exempted from payment of the special event
7 fee.
