AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$394,725 from undesignated fund balances of various funds and transferring these funds to the Health Center Construction Fund 333, amending Ordinance 10641, Sections 109 and Attachment 2, as amended, and directing that proceeds of the sale of the East Public Health Center be used to reimburse the public health pooling fund before they are deposited in Health Center Construction Fund 333.
