## ordinance no. 11179

AN ORDINANCE authorizing a land exchange of county-owned fee property and tax title property to the city of Seattle for a street vacation.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS:

King County requires the vacation of the portion of 8th Avenue which fronts the Harborview Medical Center campus in order to expand the medical center in accordance with Harborview's approved long-range capital improvement program. Compensation to the city of Seattle for this street vacation will be in the form of a land exchange. K.C.C. 4.56.140 authorizes the disposition of county property to another governmental agency upon such terms as may be agreed upon and for such consideration as may be deemed by King County to be adequate.

King County holds twelve parcels of property within the city of Seattle which the city of Seattle wishes to acquire for open space and other purposes. Nine of the parcels are held in trust by King County as tax title property. The other three parcels are owned by King County as fee property. The amount of the back taxes owed on the tax title parcels will be paid by Harborview Medical Center. Harborview Medical Center concurs with the land exchange.

The fee properties have been declared surplus, since no county use for the properties was identified.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County executive is hereby authorized to execute the necessary documents to convey the following described property to the city of Seattle to be used as greenbelts/open space tracts:
