ORDINANCE NO. **11205**

AN ORDINANCE calling for separate elections to be held to nominate and elect persons to fill the various elective offices prescribed by law for the City of Newport Hills, which will be a noncharter code city, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. On November 2, 1993, an election was held pursuant to King County Ordinance 8820 on the question of whether the area known as Newport Hills should be incorporated as a noncharter code city.

SECTION 2. On November 17, 1993, the King County canvassing board certified the results of the November 2 election on the question of incorporation, certifying that the proposed incorporation of the area known as Newport Hills had been approved.

SECTION 3. Pursuant to RCW 35.02.078, the county council hereby calls for the manager of the division of records and elections to hold separate elections to nominate and elect persons to fill the various elective offices prescribed by law for Newport Hills, based on its population and the fact that Newport Hills will be a noncharter code city.

SECTION 4. The primary election to nominate candidates for these elective positions shall be held at a special election occurring on Tuesday, February 8, 1994, as required by RCW 29.13.020.

SECTION 5. Following the primary election of February 8, the manager of records and elections shall conduct an election to fill these elective positions on Tuesday April 5, 1994, the next special election date as required in RCW 29.13.020, and it is requested that the final election be conducted by mailed ballot pursuant to RCW 29.36.120.

SECTION 6. Both elections shall be conducted by the manager of records and elections in accordance with all applicable laws and ordinances, including those related to the filing and withdrawal of declarations of candidacy.

SECTION 7. Pursuant to RCW 29.13 and 35.02, the council deems an emergency to exist for the purposed of calling for the elections referenced above.

SECTION 8. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 24th day of January, 1994.
