ORDINANCE NO. **11287**

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and approving a Family Law
Commissioner position in Superior Court, and amending
Ordinance 11130, Section 30.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 11130, Section 30, is hereby amended by adding
thereto and inserting therein the following:

The maximum number of additional FTEs for the Superior Court be: 0.375.

Provided that:

Pursuant to RCW 26.12.050 (2), the King County Council hereby authorizes and
approves creation of .375 FTE for an additional Family Law Commissioner position for
Superior Court to conduct the Permanency Planning Calendar at Juvenile Court. The
Court's appointment of a Family Law Commissioner as authorized herein is a provisional
measure to permit the Court to conduct the calendar pending evaluation of the calendar and
other potential staffing options. The Protocol Committee review shall be a part of this
evaluation. The Superior Court shall, not later than July 1, 1994, report to the Executive
and the Law, Justice, and Human Services Committee of the Council as to the Permanency
Planning Calendar and the Court's plan for permanent staffing of that calendar. The
funding necessary for the Commissioner position authorized herein shall be from existing

unencumbered funds in the Superior Court budget, such as pro tem funds. The position shall cease to exist on December 31, 1994.
