AN ORDINANCE authorizing the vacation of portions of 208th Avenue Northeast and Northeast 9th Street - V-2152. Petitioner: Stephen Saedi and others

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of that portion of 208th Avenue Northeast and Northeast 9th Street hereinafter described.
- 2. 208th Avenue Northeast and Northeast 9th Street are delineated on the plat of Inglewood, as recorded in volume 3 of plats, page 169 in King County, Washington; filed November 10, 1889 and meets the criteria for Vacation of Roads, Street, Alleys and Highways; Section 32, Ch. 19, p.603, Laws of 1889-1890.
- 3. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements are not required.
- 4. The land use section of the department of development and environmental services has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not conflict with the principals and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 5. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The department of public works considers the subject right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
- 6. In accordance with K.C.C. 14.40.020 208th Avenue Northeast and Northeast 9th Street are classified as "D Class" road vacations. The \$200.00 compensation due King County for the vacation of 208th Avenue Northeast and Northeast 9th Street was paid by the petitioner.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
