STATEMENT OF FACTS

- A petition has been filed requesting vacation of that portion of 208th Avenue Southeast hereinafter described.
- The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements are not required.
- 3. The land use section of the department of development and environmental services has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not conflict with the principals and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- As part of a proposed settlement agreement in the quiet title action, filed under King County Cause no. 92-2-07638-1 Scholes vs. Fannin and King County, Robert and Lorraine Scholes, owners of the property as described in Attachment "A", agree to quit claim to King County replacement right-of-way over their property in consideration for the County vacating the herein described portion 208th Avenue Southeast.
- The department of public works found no evidence that the subject area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The department of public works considers the subject right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
- 6. The vacated right-of-way is classified C Class and in accordance with King County Code 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on fifty percent of the appraised value of the adjoining lands which may be determined from records of the department of assessments; provided, that the council shall have the authority to accept real property of equal or greater value in lieu of cash compensation.
- The property services division has determined the property offered in exchange for the vacated portion of 208th Avenue Southeast is of equal or greater value.
- In consideration of the exchanged right-of-way King County hereby waives the \$2,217.40 compensation due for vacating 208th Avenue Southeast.
