# ORDINANCE NO. $1\overline{1}355$

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the exchange of county-owned property at Soos Creek Park for privately-owned property adjacent to the park, in Council District No. 9.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. Charlotte Huse owns certain lands, described as Parcel A in Attachment A, adjacent to Soos Creek Park in Council District No. 9.
- The acquisition of Parcel A by King County would facilitate the construction of the Soos Creek Trail (Parks CIP Project #316969 - Soos Creek Park Phase IV) by allowing the alignment of the trail outside of a wetland in the park.
- King County owns certain lands in Soos Creek Park, described as Parcel B in Attachment B.
  - Parcel B has been used by the Ms. Huse for livestock grazing.
  - The King County executive finds that Parcel B is surplus to the County's present and foreseeable needs insofar as it could be exchanged for like open space property. Therefore the executive has requested King County council approval for the exchange.
  - 6. The King County council may authorize the executive to exchange county property, including park property, in accordance with the provisions of R.C.W. 36.68.010 and K.C.C. 4.56.
  - Parcels A and B are identical in size (.505 acres) and appraised value (\$5717). King County will also pay Ms. Huse \$2800 in mitigation fees, for fencing and landscaping to reduce the impact of having a public trail adjacent to her property.
  - No objections to the exchange have been received from county agencies. The parks division has reviewed and recommends the exchange.
- The King County council has determined that it is in the best interests of King County that Parcel B, owned by King County, be surplused and exchanged for Parcel A, owned by Charlotte Huse.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County council does hereby authorize the King County executive to execute the necessary documents to exchange Parcel B for Parcel A, owned by Charlotte Huse and described in Attachment A.
