ORDINANCE NO. 11368

AN ORDINANCE relating to the implementation of a Minority and Women Loan Program and authorizing the King County Executive, the Director of the Parks, Planning and Resources Department or the Director's designee to enter into an administrative agreement with the State of Washington and to receive funds, and to enter into loan agreements with borrowers; authorizing a revenue exchange of State Development Loan Fund monies with Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds necessary to implement the program; and amending Ordinances No. 11130, Section 94, as amended, and No. 10641, Section 93, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Definitions. Unless the context otherwise requires, the terms defined in this section shall, for all purposes of this ordinance have the meanings specific; words importing the singular number include the plural number and vice versa:

"County" means King County, Washington.

"Council" means the county council of King County, Washington.

"Minority and Women Business Loan Program" shall mean the making of business loans to state certified minority and women owned enterprises for expansion and formation through funds provided by the State of Washington's Development Loan Fund.

"Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds" shall mean those entitlement monies King County receives through the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development and are dedicated to the CDBG fund.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined to be necessary and appropriate and in the best interests of the county to make loans in the amount of three hundred thirteen thousand one hundred seventy dollars to minority and women business owners for the purpose of business expansion and formation. This project will also enhance the CDBG fund by earning interest for other projects.

SECTION 3. In accordance with the regulations of the United States

Department of Housing and Urban Development, the King County executive, the

director of the parks, planning and resources department or the director's designee is hereby authorized to enter into an administrative agreement with the State of Washington to receive Development Loan Fund monies. The King County executive, the director of the parks, planning and resources department or the director's designee is further authorized to enter into loan agreements with minority and women business owners. The loans shall be repaid to King County in accordance with the term and conditions of the Washington State Development Loan Fund agreement.

SECTION 4. In accordance with the regulations of the United States

Department of Housing and Urban Development, the sum of up to three hundred thirteen thousand one hundred seventy dollars of CDBG funds is authorized to be exchanged from Project No. C94608 King County Housing Development Setaside and Project No. C93520 King County Housing Rehab: Loan Funds with funds from the Washington State Development Loan Fund. These CDBG funds shall be used for the purpose of making minority and women business loans.

<u>SECTION 5</u>. Ordinance 11130, Section 94, as amended, is hereby amended adding thereto and inserting therein the following:
