AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$40,781 to the Department of Public Safety and \$159,249 to the Superior Court from Special Programs - Executive Contingency, for Courthouse security, and amending Ordinance 11130, Sections 16, 30, and 38, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There are hereby approved and adopted appropriations of \$40,781 to the department of public safety, and \$159,249 to the superior court from Special Programs - Executive Contingency to support the courthouse security program.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 11130, Section 16, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

PUBLIC SAFETY - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Public Safety \$40,781

The maximum number of additional FTEs for Public Safety shall be: 0.50

SECTION 3. Ordinance 11130, Section 30, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

SUPERIOR COURT - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Superior Court \$159,249

The maximum number of additional FTEs for the Superior Court shall be: 2.50

SECTION 4. Ordinance 11130, Section 38, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:
