- The land use section of the department of development and environmental services has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not conflict with the principals and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates no public funds were expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The department of public works considers the subject right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
- The west 84 feet of right-of-way is classified C Class. The remainder of right-of-way is classified B Class and in accordance with King County Code Section 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on fifty percent for C class and seventy-five percent for B Class of the appraised value of the adjoining lands which may be determined from records of the department of assessments. King County is in receipt of \$8,424.00 from the petitioner.
- The petitioner has requested that the legal description on the petition to vacate be revised to exclude the East 36 feet of maintained right-of-way.
- The revision causes an over payment of compensation in the amount of \$2,527.20. This amount will be refunded to the petitioner.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the office of the zoning and subdivision examiner on the 24___ day of _____May
