STATEMENT OF FACT

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of that portion of Southeast 320th Street hereinafter described.
- 2. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that the City of Auburn, Public Works Department has acquired a 30-foot easement in the vacation area for an existing sanitary sewer.
- 3. The land use section of the department of development and environmental services has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The department of public works found that the vacation area has been improved for travel and maintained within the last twenty years. A search of the records indicates that public funds have been expended for its improvement and maintenance. The department of public works considers the subject right of way unnecessary as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this area to the public tax rolls.
- 5. The right-of-way is classified B Class and in accordance with King County Code 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on seventy-five percent of the appraised value of the adjoining lands which may be determined from records of the department of assessments. King County is in receipt of \$16,481.70 from the petitioner. In light of the public purpose of this vacation, and the benefits and cost savings provided to King County by the petitioner, waiver of the compensation serves the interests of King County and should be permitted pursuant to KCC 14.40.020.D.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the office of the zoning and subdivision examiner on the 24th day of May, 1994.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
