ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE appropriating a net total of \$5,336,898 to the Emergency Communications Fund with \$1,664,816 from unappropriated fund balance and \$3,672,082 from 1994 property tax revenues to provide for continued implementation of the Regional Emergency Radio Communications System; disappropriating a total of \$834,824 for discontinued Port of Seattle participation; and amending Ordinance 11130, Section 117 and Attachment 2, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$5,336,898 to the Emergency Communications Fund with \$1,664,816 from Emergency Communications Fund unappropriated fund balance, and \$3,672,082 from 1994 Emergency Communications Fund property tax revenues, to provide \$1,078,924 for the Eastside Public Safety Communications Agency, \$1,151,372 for the Valley Communications Center, \$3,276,980 for the King County Radio Project, and \$664,446 for the Central Allocation Project for continued implementation of the Emergency Radio Communications System; and a disappropriation of \$834,824 for discontinued Port of Seattle participation in the implementation of the Emergency Radio Communications System.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 11130, Section 117, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

From the several capital improvement funds there are hereby appropriated and authorized to be disbursed the following amounts for the specific projects identified in Attachment No. 2 of this ordinance:
