

ORDINANCE NO. **11445**

AN ORDINANCE relating to the establishment of Southeast Petrovitsky Road between 143rd Avenue Southeast and 151st Avenue Southeast.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The director of the department of public works has made an examination of Southeast Petrovitsky Road between 143rd Avenue Southeast and 151st Avenue Southeast along a course and description set forth below and has made favorable report upon same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

SECTION 2. Southeast Petrovitsky Road shall be established at not less than one hundred feet in width, having fifty feet of such width each side of the following described centerline: commencing at a point on the centerline of 143rd Avenue Southeast, said point being south 81° 07' 17" east a distance of 937.48 feet from the north quarter corner of section 34, township 23 north, range 5 east, W.M. and designated as engineer's station 117+87.10 as surveyed by King County (survey no. 34-23-05-10); thence south 66° 43' 02" east 2835.82 feet to the terminus point of this establishment, said terminus point being north 69° 27' 08" west a distance of 4566.03 feet from the east quarter corner of section 35, township 23 north, range 5 east, W.M. 2835.82 feet = .54 mile m/l.
