

ORDINANCE NO **11457**

AN ORDINANCE making appropriations of \$610,643 to the Grant Fund for support of programs to evaluate the effectiveness of community-based interventions in decreasing delays in heart attack patients, and in determining the effectiveness of prehospital interventions on long-term survival and health status of sudden cardiac death patients; amending Ordinance No. 11130, Section 92, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$427,858 to the Grant Fund from the National Heart, Lung and Blood Institute, National Institutes of Health, for support of a project entitled community heart action plan, Grant File No. 345.

SECTION 2. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$71,155 to the Grant Fund from the University of Washington for support of a project entitled Survivors of out-of-hospital cardiac arrest: a population-based registry, Grant File No. 237.

SECTION 3. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$43,890 to the Grant Fund from the American Heart Association for support of a project entitled Survivors of out-of-hospital cardiac arrest: do pre-hospital interventions determine long-term activity status and neuropsychological function , Grant File No. 353.

SECTION 4. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$67,740 to the Grant Fund from the Medic One Foundation for support of a project entitled Survivors of out-of-hospital cardiac arrest, Grant File No 356.

SECTION 5. Ordinance 11130, Section 92, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:
