ORDINANCE NO. **11478**

2 AN ORDINANCE dissolving Television
3 Reception Improvement District No. 1,
4 authorizing the sale of the district's
5 property, and repealing Ordinance 1425.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. Findings. Based on testimony received at a
8 public hearing held on the *12th* day of *September*, 1994,
9 and other evidence before it, the metropolitan King County
10 council hereby finds that Television Reception Improvement
11 District No. 1, established by Ordinance 1425 to serve the
12 Skykomish area of King County, no longer serves the purposes
13 of R.C.W. 36.95.

14 SECTION 2. Ordinance 1425 is hereby repealed and the
15 district is dissolved, pursuant to R.C.W. 36.95.200.

16 SECTION 3. The executive is authorized to sell at
17 public auction, and in conformance with the requirements of
18 R.C.W. 36.34 and K.C.C. 4.56, any and all property of
19 marketable value formerly owned by the district.

SECTION 4. Any fund balance remaining in the district account and any proceeds from the sale of district property shall be applied to the county current expense fund, after satisfaction of any outstanding obligations of the district, pursuant to R.C.W. 36.95.200 and R.C.W. 36.96.070.
