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7 ORDINANCE NO. **11513**

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9 AN ORDINANCE relating to hazardous waste management fees; amending
10 Rules and Regulations No. 66, Section 1 (part), and the code of the King
11 County Board of Health 2.08.030 and 2.08.090.

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13 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY, AS THE KING
14 COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH PURSUANT TO RCW 70.05:

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16 **SECTION 1.** Effective January 1, 1995, Rules and Regulations No. 66, Section 1
17 (part), and the Code of the King County Board of Health 2.08.030 are hereby amended to
18 read as follows:

19 **2.08.030 Landfill defined.** "Landfill" means a disposal facility or part of a facility
20 at which solid waste is placed in or on land and which is not a land treatment facility.

21 ~~((Facilities that exclusively accept construction wastes, demolition wastes, and/or land
22 clearing wastes are exempt from Section 2.08.090, Subsections C and D.))~~

23 **SECTION 2.** Effective January 1, 1995, Rules and Regulations No. 66, Section 1
24 (part), and the Code of the King County Board of Health 2.08.090 are hereby amended to
25 read as follows:

26 **2.08.090 Fees.** The following fees are established to provide funds for contracts
27 authorized by Section 2.08.085(B):

28 A. Each private and public entity which bills for solid waste collection services
29 shall pay an amount equivalent to sixty cents (\$0.60) per month for each residential customer
30 in King County, and ~~((five dollars and twenty five cents (\$5.25)))~~ six dollars and seventy-
31 seven cents (\$6.77) per month for each customer in King county which is not a residential
32 customer. Billings from the department to each entity as above shall be based on actual
33 customer data from the preceding calendar year.

34 B. Each operator of a sewage treatment plant serving more than fifty (50)
35 customers shall pay an amount equivalent to ~~((seventeen dollars and fifty seven cents
36 (\$17.57)))~~ twenty-five dollars and thirty-one cents (\$25.31) per million (1,000,000) gallons
37 of sewage treated. Billings from the department to each operator as above shall be based on
38 actual performance data from the preceding calendar year.

1 C. Each transfer station and landfill shall pay one dollar (\$1.00) for each
2 passenger licensed vehicle load of solid waste brought to such transfer station or landfill.

3 D. Each transfer station and landfill shall pay two dollars and sixty-one cents
4 (\$2.61) per ton for each load of solid waste brought to such transfer station or landfill by a
5 self hauler.

6 Billings from the department to each transfer station and landfill operator as above
7 shall be based on actual performance data from the preceding calendar quarter.

8 All fees shall be billed and remitted to the department on a quarterly basis. All
9 payments shall be due ((~~sixty (60)~~)) forty-five (45) days after receipt of bill.
