ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to school impact fees; adopting the Capital Facilities Plans of the Tahoma, Federal Way, Riverview, Issaquah, Snoqualmie Valley, Highline, Lake Washington, Kent, and Northshore School Districts as subelements of the capital facilities element of the King County Comprehensive Plan for purposes of implementing the impact fee program; establishing impact fees to be collected by King County on behalf of the districts; and amending Ordinance 10122, Section 2 and 3 and K.C.C. 27.44.010 and K.C.C. 20.12.460, Ordinance 10470, Section 2 and K.C.C. 20.12.461, Ordinance 10472, Section 2 and K.C.C. 20.12.463, Ordinance 10633, Section 2 and K.C.C. 20.12.464 and K.C.C. 20.12.465, Ordinance 10790, Section 2 and K.C.C. 20.12.466, Ordinance 10982, Section 2 and K.C.C. 20.12.467, and Ordinance 11148, Section 2 and K.C.C. 20.12.468.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Authority. This ordinance is adopted to implement King County Comprehensive Plan policies, the 1990 Growth Management Act, and Ordinance No. 10162 with respect to Tahoma School District, Federal Way School District, Riverview School District, Issaquah School District, Snoqualmie Valley School District, Highline School District, Lake Washington School District, Kent School District, and Northshore School District. This ordinance is necessary to address identified impacts of development on the Districts in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare, and to implement King County's authority to impose impact fees pursuant to RCW 82.02.050 through RCW 82.02.080.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 10122, Section 3 and K.C.C. 20.12.460 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Tahoma School District Capital Facilities Plan. The Tahoma School District No. 409 Capital Facilities Plan ((1993-94-te-1998-99)) 1994-95 to 1999-00, dated ((May,-1993)) April 1994, revised June 30, 1994 which is included in Attachment A and incorporated herein by reference, is adopted as a subelement of the capital facilities element of the Comprehensive Plan for King County, and augments and amplifies the Plan.

SECTION 3. Ordinance 10470, Section 2 and K.C.C. 20.12.461 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Federal Way School District Capital Facilities Plan. The Federal Way School District No. 210 ((1992/93)) 1993/94 Capital Facilities Plan dated April 1994 which is included in Attachment B and incorporated herein by reference, is adopted as a subelement of the capital facilities element of the Comprehensive Plan for King County, and augments and amplifies the Plan.

SECTION 4. Ordinance 10472, Section 2 and K.C.C. 20.12.462 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Riverview School District Capital Facilities Plan. The Riverview School District No. 407 Capital Facilities Plan, dated April 1, ((1993)) 1994, revised ((June-10;-1993)) June 14, 1994, which is included in Attachment C and is incorporated herein by reference, is adopted as a subelement of the capital facilities element of the Comprehensive Plan for King County, and augments and amplifies the Plan.

SECTION 5. Ordinance 10633, Section 2 and K.C.C. 20.12.463 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Issaquah School District Capital Facilities Plan. The Issaquah School District No. 411 ((1993)) 1994 Capital Facilities Plan, ((March-24;-1993; Revised-May-28;-1993)) dated April 13, 1994, which is included in Attachment D and is incorporated herein by reference, is adopted as a subelement of the capital facilities element of the Comprehensive Plan for King County, and augments and amplifies the Plan.

<u>SECTION 6</u>. Ordinance 10722, Section 2 and K.C.C. 20.12.464 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Snoqualmie Valley School District Capital Facilities Plan. The Snoqualmie Valley School District No. 410 Capital Facilities Plan, ((amended Nevember-12,-1992)) dated June 23, 1994, amended July 26, 1994, which is included in Attachment ((A)) E and is incorporated herein by reference, is adopted as a subelement of the capital facilities element of the Comprehensive Plan for King County, and augments and amplifies the Plan.

 SECTION 7. Ordinance 10722, Section 3 and K.C.C. 20.12.465 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Highline School District Capital Facilities Plan. The Highline Public Schools District No. 401 Capital Facilities Plan ((1991/92)) 1994, revised ((Nevember-1992)) June 1994, which is included in Attachment ((B)) F and is incorporated herein by reference, is adopted as a subelement of the capital facilities element of the Comprehensive Plan for King County, and augments and amplifies the Plan.

SECTION 8. Ordinance 10790, Section 2 and K.C.C. 20.12.466 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Lake Washington School District Capital Facilities Plan. The Lake Washington School District No. 414 Capital Facilities Plan, ((1992/1993--1997/1998;-as-amended-January-7;-1993)) 1993/1994 - 1998/1999, dated June 1994, which is included in Attachment ((A)) G and is incorporated herein by reference, is adopted as a subelement of the capital facilities element of the Comprehensive Plan for King County, and augments and amplifies the Plan.

SECTION 9. Ordinance 10982, Section 2 and K.C.C. 20.12.467 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Kent School District Capital Facilities Plan. Kent School District No. 415 Capital Facilities Plan, ((1993-94---1998-99;-revised-May-1993)) 1994-1995 - 1999-2000, dated April 1994, which is included in Attachment ((A)) H which is incorporated herein by reference, is adopted as a subelement of the capital facilities element of the Comprehensive Plan for King County, and augments and amplifies the Plan.

SECTION 10. Ordinance 11148, Section 2 and K.C.C. 20.12.468 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Northshore School District Capital Facilities Plan. The Northshore School District No. 417 Capital Facilities Plan, dated ((August-30,-1993, revised-September-16,-1993)) June 1994, which is included in Attachment ((A)) I and is incorporated herein by reference, is adopted as a subelement of the capital facilities element of the Comprehensive Plan for King County, and augments and amplifies the Plan.

SECTION 11. Ordinance No. 10122, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 27.44.010 are hereby amended to read as follows:
