Attachment 1

Statement of Residual Balances of Funds Proposed for Closure

The following balances are approximate due to arbitrage calculations and interest earnings. A final arbitrage calculation will precede the closing of each of these funds (with the exception of the West Seattle Freeway Bridge Construction Fund which has no arbitrage liability) and the resulting adjustment to the arbitrage liability may change these amounts. Amounts transferred will also reflect interest earnings up to the time of closure. The Fund Managers for each of these funds are aware of the arbitrage implications and have approved the proposed disposition of these remaining balances.

Courthouse Complex Construction Fund 1987 (3040)

\$4,000

This balance should be transferred to the Building Modernization Construction Fund (3310). The related projects were completed in Fund 3310, but revenue from the Courthouse Complex Construction Fund was never transferred to cover the expenditures.

Parks Construction 1987 Fund (3060)

\$384,500

This balance should be transferred to the Parks, Recreation and Open Space Fund (3160). The related projects were completed in Fund 3160, but the revenue from the Parks Construction 1987 Fund was never transferred to cover the expenditures.

West Seattle Freeway Bridge Construction Fund (3100)

\$200

This balance should be transferred to the Current Expense Fund which paid the debt service on the bond issue providing the resources for Fund 3100.

Aquatic Facility Acquisition Fund (3240)

\$1,200

This balance should be transferred to the Building Modernization Construction Fund (3310), as reimbursement for an operating transfer made to Fund 3240 in 1991.

West Seattle Bridge Phase II Construction Fund (3250)

\$109,700

This balance should be transferred to the Current Expense Fund which paid the debt service on the bond issue providing the resources for Fund 3250.

Park Acquisition and Development Fund (Forward Thrust) (3370) \$22,400

Outstanding receivables and payables should be transferred to the Current Expense Fund, low org. 7401, for disposition. Any remaining fund balance should be transferred to the Parks, Recreation and Open Space Fund (3160) for parks acquisition or development purposes.

Automated Fingerprint Identification System Acq. Fund (3070) \$183,000

This balance should be transferred to the AFIS Operating Fund (1220) to be used for one time expenditures related to the operation of the AFIS.

All of the resources of the following funds have been expended; therefore, no transfers of balances are required:

Stadium Public Seating Facilities Acquisition Fund (3920)

Stadium Loges and Restaurant Construction Fund (3930)

District Courts Acquisition and Construction Fund (3970)

Limited Stadium General Obligation Bond Redemption Fund (8440)
