ORDINANCE NO. 11613

AN ORDINANCE relating to elections, calling for special elections to be held to nominate and to elect persons to fill the prescribed elective offices for the newly incorporated city of Shoreline, and declaring an emergency.

## PREAMBLE:

On September 20, 1994, a special election was held pursuant to King County Ordinance No. 11382 on the question of whether the area known as Shoreline should be incorporated as a noncharter code city.

On September 30, 1994, the King County canvassing board certified the results of the special election on the question of incorporation certifying that the proposed incorporation of the area known as Shoreline had been approved.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the RCW 35.02.078 and RCW 29.13.010, the county council hereby calls for the records and elections division manager, as supervisor of elections, to hold special elections for the purpose of nominating and electing persons to fill the elective offices prescribed by law for the city of Shoreline based on its population and its classification as a noncharter code city with a councilmanager form of government.

SECTION 2. The primary to nominate candidates for the prescribed elective positions shall be held at a special election occurring on Tuesday, February 7, 1995; and the special election to fill the prescribed elective positions shall be held on Tuesday, April 25, 1995.

SECTION 3. Both special elections shall be conducted in accordance with all applicable laws and ordinances, including

those related to the filing and withdrawal of candidacy 1 declarations contained in Chapter 29.15 RCW. 2 SECTION 4. It is hereby found that an urgent need 3 exists for the consideration by the electors of the proposed 4 incorporated City of Shoreline to fill the positions of the 5 Shoreline City Council. Pursuant to RCW 29.13.010 and RCW 6 35.02.130, it is hereby deemed that an emergency exists 7 requiring that the elections called for in section two of 8 9 this ordinance be held.
