ORDINANCE NO.

**11636**

AN ORDINANCE relating to levying the  
property taxes of King County for the year  
of 1995.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The County Assessor of King County has  
certified to the county council that the assessed valuation of  
the County of King as finally equalized amounts to  
\$121,698,613,370 and as adjusted for senior citizens exemptions  
provided for in RCW 84.36.381, and for omitted assessments in  
accordance with RCW 84.36.381, is \$120,785,318,435.

SECTION 2. The Council of King County, Washington, finds  
that the levies necessary to fund estimated expenditures for  
the year 1995, less the total of estimated revenues from  
sources other than taxation, including available surplus and  
such expenditures as are to be met from bond warrant issues, be  
and the same are hereby fixed as follows:
