ORDINANCE NO. **11646**

AN ORDINANCE approving the King County Water District No. 107 Comprehensive Water System Plan.

PREAMBLE:

K.C.C. 13.24 requires approval of comprehensive plans for water purveyors as a prerequisite to the granting of right-of-way franchises and approval of right-of-way construction permits.

On April 29, 1994 the King County Utilities Technical Review Committee met to consider the plan and finding it consistent with K.C.C. 13.24 recommended approval.

The King County Water District No. 107 Comprehensive Water System Plan was approved by vote of the district commissioners on August 24, 1994.

The King County Water District No. 107 issued a determination of nonsignificance for the Plan in accordance with the State Environmental Policy Act on March 23, 1993.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Water District No. 107 Comprehensive Water System Plan, attached as Exhibit A, and the Water Shortage Contingency Plan, attached as Exhibit B, are hereby approved without conditions.
