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ordinance no. 11677

AN ORDINANCE relating to solid waste division fees, identifying passenger cars as a fee category and charging all other passenger licensed vehicles on a tonnage basis; amending Ordinance 6177, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 10.12.020.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 6177, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 10.12.020 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Fees for use of disposal sites. All persons using countyoperated solid waste disposal facilities shall pay the service fees set forth in the following schedules:

A. ((Effective September 1, 1993 s)) Service fees for the use of disposal sites with scales, excluding Cedar Hills, shall be:

((Effective July 1, 1991, a)) A moderate risk waste 8 surcharge shall be added to all solid waste disposed by non-solid 9 waste collection entities using county operated disposal facilities. 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F. In the absence of exact weights or measurements, the estimate of the manager shall be binding upon the user.

Special Service Fee. Solid waste generated and/or collected within the boundaries of a jurisdiction which has not entered into an agreement with King County for use of King County solid waste disposal facilities as provided by this chapter may only be disposed of in a King County facility upon payment of a special service fee of 3 times the applicable per ton rate for facilities with scales and 3 times the applicable cubic yard rate for compacted or uncompacted wastes for facilities without Payment of the special service fee in this subsection shall be in lieu of payment of the fees in subsections A-E. Nothing in this subsection authorizes the use of King County facilities by any municipal corporation or agent thereof or any commercial hauler for disposal of solid waste generated and/or collected outside King County.
