

ORDINANCE NO. **11677**

AN ORDINANCE relating to solid waste division fees, identifying passenger cars as a fee category and charging all other passenger licensed vehicles on a tonnage basis; amending Ordinance 6177, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 10.12.020.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 6177, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 10.12.020 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Fees for use of disposal sites. All persons using county-operated solid waste disposal facilities shall pay the service fees set forth in the following schedules:

A. (~~Effective September 1, 1993~~s) Service fees for the use of disposal sites with scales, excluding Cedar Hills, shall be:

1. Solid waste disposal:

 8 surcharge shall be added to all solid waste disposed by non-solid

22 E. (~~Effective January 1, 1992, a~~) special waste fee shall
 23 be charged for special waste including infectious waste treated
 24 and handled pursuant to King County Board of Health Code
 25 10.28.070, asbestos-containing waste material, bulky waste,
 26 problem wastes, and other additional wastes requiring clearances
 27 pursuant to the King County Board of Health Code Title 10 or
 28 pursuant to rules promulgated by the department.

1 F. In the absence of exact weights or measurements, the
2 estimate of the manager shall be binding upon the user.

3 G. Special Service Fee. Solid waste generated and/or
4 collected within the boundaries of a jurisdiction which has not
5 entered into an agreement with King County for use of King County
6 solid waste disposal facilities as provided by this chapter may
7 only be disposed of in a King County facility upon payment of a
8 special service fee of 3 times the applicable per ton rate for
9 facilities with scales and 3 times the applicable cubic yard rate
10 for compacted or uncompacted wastes for facilities without
11 scales. Payment of the special service fee in this subsection
12 shall be in lieu of payment of the fees in subsections A-E.
13 Nothing in this subsection authorizes the use of King County
14 facilities by any municipal corporation or agent thereof or any
15 commercial hauler for disposal of solid waste generated and/or
16 collected outside King County.

1 SECTION 2. The effective date of this ordinance shall be
2 April 1, 1995.
